**SUBJECT: CDMA Retirement Information**

Please be advised that Verizon Wireless (“VZW”) will be updating its CDMA service (i.e., 1xRTT and EVDO), with Network adjustments starting on July 1, 2018. VZW has announced that it intends to retire its CDMA network (1x/EVDO, 2G/3G) on December 31, 2019. In anticipation of this retirement, VZW will no longer allow the Activation of new devices on CDMA after June 30, 2018. For devices Activated on CDMA prior to June 30, 2018, VZW will continue support limited account servicing, such as Device ID Change, MDN Change, Price Plan Change, Suspend and Resume, and Reactivate MDN, through July 1, 2019.

Beginning **July 1, 2018**, VZW will implement the following updates:

- Only HD Voice-enabled Smartphones, HD Voice-enabled Basic Phones and 4G LTE data-only Verizon Wireless certified devices may be Activated on the Verizon Wireless network (Postpaid and Prepaid Services).
- Only HD Voice-enabled Smartphones, HD Voice-enabled Basic Phones and 4G LTE data-only IMEI uploads will be accepted to the Verizon Wireless Device Management Database (DMD).

Beginning **July 1, 2019**, the following maintenance activities on non-HD Voice Smartphones or 3G data-only devices will no longer be available for your use:

- Rate plan and feature changes
- MDN changes
- Apply and restore from Hotline and Suspend status
- Restore de-Activations that were made in error, per Verizon Wireless’ requirements
- SIM changes on existing non HD Voice Smartphones

After **July 1, 2019**, Upgrades from CDMA-only devices to HD Voice-enabled Smartphones, HD Voice-enabled Basic Phones and 4G LTE data-only devices will continue to be allowed.

A summary of this timing is provided for your reference in the attached Exhibit 1.

A summary of the current exceptions is provided for your reference in the attached Exhibit 2. Please be advised that these exceptions are subject to change at any time at VZW’s sole discretion.

Please be advised that VZW reserves the right to alter this schedule or adjust its retirement plan at its sole discretion. To the extent practicable, VZW will update Agent on schedule or planning changes, if any, to the extent that such changes may impact Agent's obligations to service VZW accounts and Subscribers.

All terms and conditions as set forth in your Agreement, including, without limitation, those relating to the payment of Compensation, remain in effect. The capitalized terms used in this notice shall have the same meanings as set forth in your Agreement.
